Dear Servicemember or Veteran,

We have received notification of your discharge from the military. We want to welcome you home and thank you for your service to our Country. Our office is your connection to the benefits you have earned.

Questions to consider after release from active duty:

- 1) Have you submitted your DD-214 to your CVSO to be recorded with the Register of Deeds in your county?
- 2) Did you incur an injury or disability while in the military?
- 3) Were you seen or did you receive medical care for injuries or illnesses while you were on active duty?
- 4) Are you enrolled in VA Healthcare?
- 5) Have you utilized your State and/or Federal education benefits?

We strongly recommend that you call to discuss all VA benefits you may be entitled to. We can record copies 1 and 4 of your DD-214 with the Door County Register of Deeds in the event that it is misplaced. Your DD-214 is a very important document that determines your eligibility to VA Benefits. Please call our office to schedule an appointment if you would like to pursue or have questions regarding any of the benefits you are entitled to.
