

Wisconsin's Well Testing Access Program (WellTAP)

The Wisconsin Well Testing Access Program (WellTAP) provides no-cost testing for bacteria, nitrate, fluoride, and metals to qualified private well users.

While most private wells provide safe drinking water, some may contain substances that can impact health.

Because many substances do not affect the color, smell, or taste of the water, Door County Public Health recommends that all well users test their well water regularly.

Well users that qualify for WellTAP:



Have a well that regularly serves a pregnant person, child (12 or under), or person with a weakened immune system.



Will test the well that serves their primary residence.



Are experiencing a financial or other burden that prevents them from being able to test on their own.
